Police Asking for Information about ATM Robberies

Durham police investigators are asking for information about three armed robberies that have occurred during the last two months at the drive-through ATM at Bank of America at 4811 Hope Valley Road.

Investigators believe the same person is responsible for all three robberies. The suspect is described as a black male, 20 to 30 years old and 5 feet 10 inches to 6 feet tall with a medium build. He usually wears a black hoodie and a bandana over his face.



Police are investigating the following robberies:

- October 3 at 10:16 p.m. – A female had just gotten money out of the ATM when a male approached her car, pointed a gun at her and took her money. He also forced her to get additional money from the ATM.
- November 8 at 11:44 p.m. – A male was getting money from the ATM when a male approached his car, pointed a gun at him and took his money and his debit card.
- November 14 at 12:36 a.m. – A female was depositing a check at the ATM when a male approached her, pointed a gun at her and demanded money.
