Durham Man Arrested on Robbery Charges

Shaquan Altrek Johnson was arrested today in Fayetteville by members of the U.S. Marshals Service Fugitive Task Force and charged with committing several armed robberies in Durham during April.

Johnson, 22, of Old Harness Place is charged with committing the following robberies:

1. **April 12 – 10:40 p.m. in the 600 block of Cecil Street** – A male armed with a gun entered a house through an unlocked door and robbed the two occupants of a laptop computer, two cell phones and cash.
2. **April 16 - 9:18 p.m. at 24 Hour Check Cashing, 2107 North Roxboro Street** – The victim was getting in her vehicle in the parking lot of the business when a male armed with a black handgun approached her, pointed a gun at her head and robbed her of cash and a cell phone. A second female was also getting in the car, but was not robbed. The suspect was described as a black male, 19 to 25 years old, 5 feet 6 inches to 5 feet 10 inches tall with a medium build. He was wearing dark clothing.
3. **April 16 - 9:31 p.m. at Raleigh-Durham Check Cashing, 1504 Broad Street** – The victims were getting in their vehicle in the parking lot of the business when a male got out of a vehicle parked in the corner of the parking lot and robbed both of them at gunpoint. The male got back in the passenger side of the vehicle, which was described as a brown or black 4-door car. The suspect was described as a black male, 5 feet 8 inches to 6 feet tall wearing dark clothing. He was armed with a black pistol.
4. **April 16 - 9:53 p.m. in the 200 block of North Duke Street** - A male approached two females at the Shell convenience store on West Main Street and started a conversation with them. The females left the store and started to walk on Duke Street. A short time later, the male who spoke to them in the convenience store approached them on the street, pulled out a black handgun and demanded money. The victims did not give him any cash and he fled. He was described as a

black male, 20 to 22 years old, 5 feet 5 inches to 5 feet 9 inches with a medium build and partially braided hair pulled back with a rubber band. He was wearing a black hoodie, blue jeans with red writing on the back and black/brown low top Nike shoes.

5. **April 16 - 21:59 p.m. in the 700 block of South Mangum Street** – A male was walking on Mangum Street when a male walked out from an apartment complex, pulled out a black handgun and demanded money. He took the victim's wallet and cell phone. The suspect was described as a black male, 17 to 22 years old, 5 feet 8 inches to 5 feet 10 inches tall, 120 to 140 pounds with a dark complexion. He was wearing a black hoodie and dark clothing.
